I am requesting funding for the Mobile Command Post Project in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, located at 211 W Temple Street, Los Angeles, 90012. The funding would be used to procure a new Mobile Command Post (MCP) and two MCP support vehicles that will double as patrol cruisers for the LASD Lancaster Station. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will better enable the incident commander in significant incidents to make the crucial decisions that will impact the entire operation in the interest of public safety and criminal justice.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
