Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Hasley Canyon Stormwater Improvement Project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Los Angeles County Public Works, located at 900 S. Fremont, Alhambra, CA 91803. The funding would be used improve water quality by reducing trash, bacteria, nitrogen, and metal pollutants from entering the Santa Clara River by diverting, treat, and infiltrate approximately 38 acre-feet of stormwater in an average rainfall year from a 150-acre developed drainage area. This project is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it will improve the water quality and stormwater management for a community that traditionally struggles with periods of drought and flooding.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
